

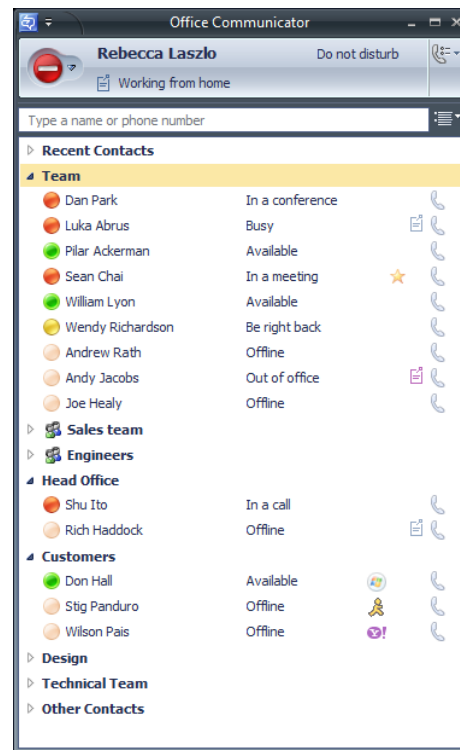

With rich presence awareness, software-powered voice capabilities, enterprise-class Instant Messaging (IM), and multi-party audio and video conferencing, you can connect and collaborate from any location with Internet connectivity. Closely integrated with the Microsoft Office system, Office Communicator 2007 links seamlessly with the applications you use most—including Microsoft® Office Outlook® 2007, Microsoft® Office SharePoint® sites, and others.

Find the Right People, Right Now

With the rich presence awareness of Office Communicator 2007, you can quickly find the people you need and determine the best way to reach them.

- **Simplify communications with immediate presence awareness.**
Office Communicator 2007 provides an immediate, visual representation of a person's availability, or presence. Find out whether a person is online, on a call, in a meeting, or out of the office. Presence states such as "Do Not Disturb" and custom messages give you more information about a person's availability. You can also tag a contact to find out when their presence information changes and receive automatic notification when they become available.



Presence awareness information lets you see a contact's availability in real time.

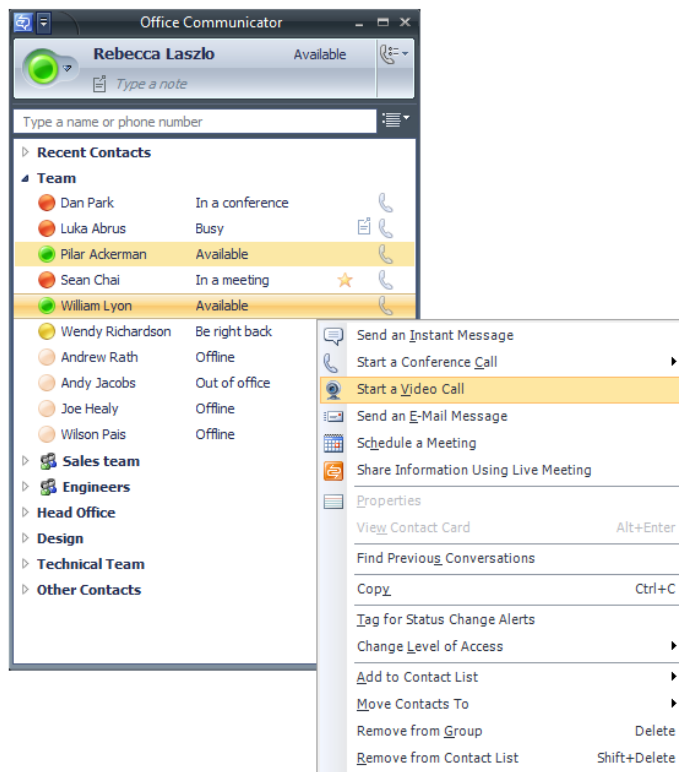
- **Let others know the best way to contact you.**

Presence states are set automatically based on your Outlook calendar, computer activity, and whether you are on a call. You can choose to set your presence state manually, add a custom note, and customize your current location. The access level functionality lets you control the information that others see, such as your mobile phone number or your Outlook calendar information.

- **Manage your contacts more easily.**

Contact management features make it easy and intuitive to organize contacts and initiate conversations. Search for individual contacts or Corporate Distribution Groups, and then view their presence, start a conversation, or add them to your Contact List. You can view contacts based on availability, access levels, or custom groups. Contact Cards provide detailed information and a menu of communication options.

Start a conversation with IM, move to a call, and add a video if that would be most effective. Transition from a person-to-person call to a conference or escalate to a web conference so that participants can share applications, slides, or their desktop. You can connect to a web conference either through the conferencing capabilities of Microsoft® Office

Start a video call instantly by selecting multiple names from your Contact List.

- **Access powerful phone features through your PC.**

With Office Communicator 2007, your PC becomes your phone by delivering a range of phone features through a software-powered experience. Place calls from your computer to another computer—or to a phone—from any connected location. Flexible calling options let you forward calls to a different phone number, simultaneously ring an additional number, and redirect unanswered calls.

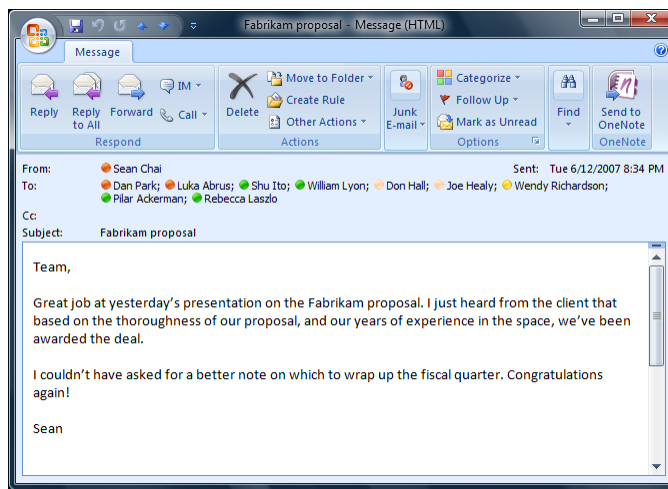
Office Communicator 2007 integrates seamlessly with the familiar Microsoft Office applications you use everyday.
